Gerald also gave a nod to the 5,000 employees who couldn’t be in the room, but as the engine of the business, contribute to its success.

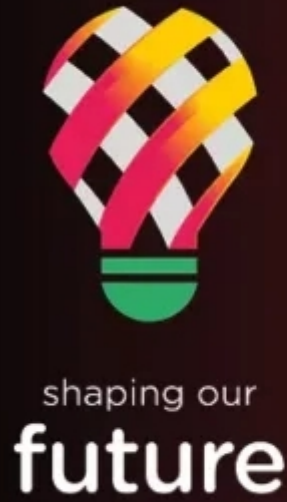
