Siyazigabisa (meaning “we have pride” in Zulu) was established in 1997 in a rented back room and has grown through various corporate support to a 727m² building. Gabsile Khoza founded the home to protect especially young girls after she herself was the victim of abuse at age eight.

With a mission to bring hope to the hopeless, the home aims to raise the children in a loving atmosphere so that they can rebuild their lives and one day take their place in society with pride.
